Find A Need And Fill It
Back from WWII, my Grandfather Tom and his brother Bill joined their dad at Kirby Implement Company in Merced, Ca. A local dairyman had a need for a mechanized way to feed his cows. Tom and Bill developed the first "self unloading forage wagon" in 1949 and that was the beginning of Kirby Manufacturing. Since that time we have grown to over 100 people and the family still runs the business the way Tom and Bill began it.

We Do What Ever It Takes To Feed The Cows
You don't stay in business for three generations without taking care of your customer. We know that if a dairyman or cattleman can't feed their cows, he is out of business. 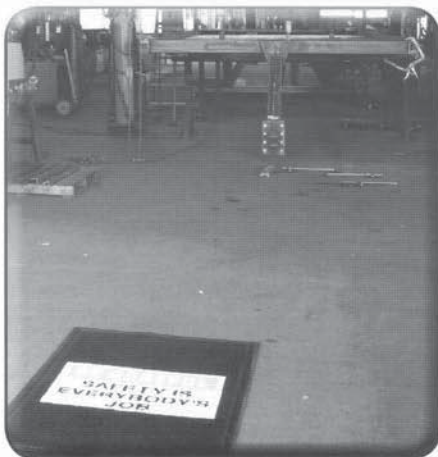

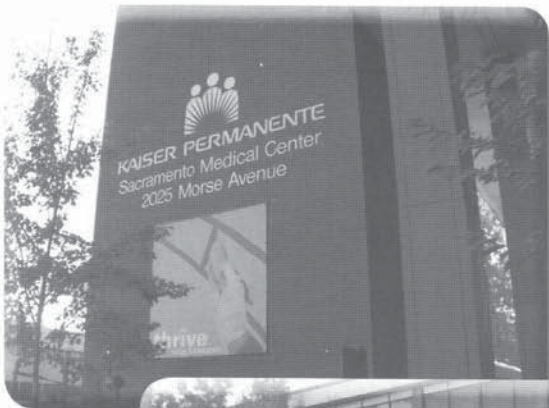

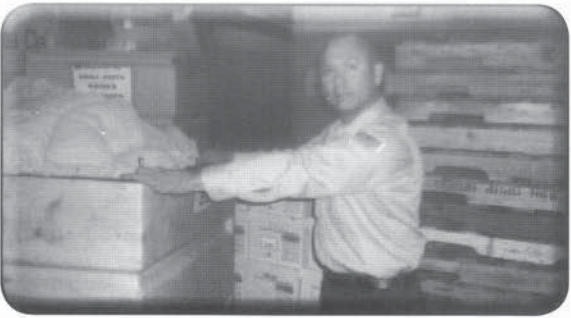

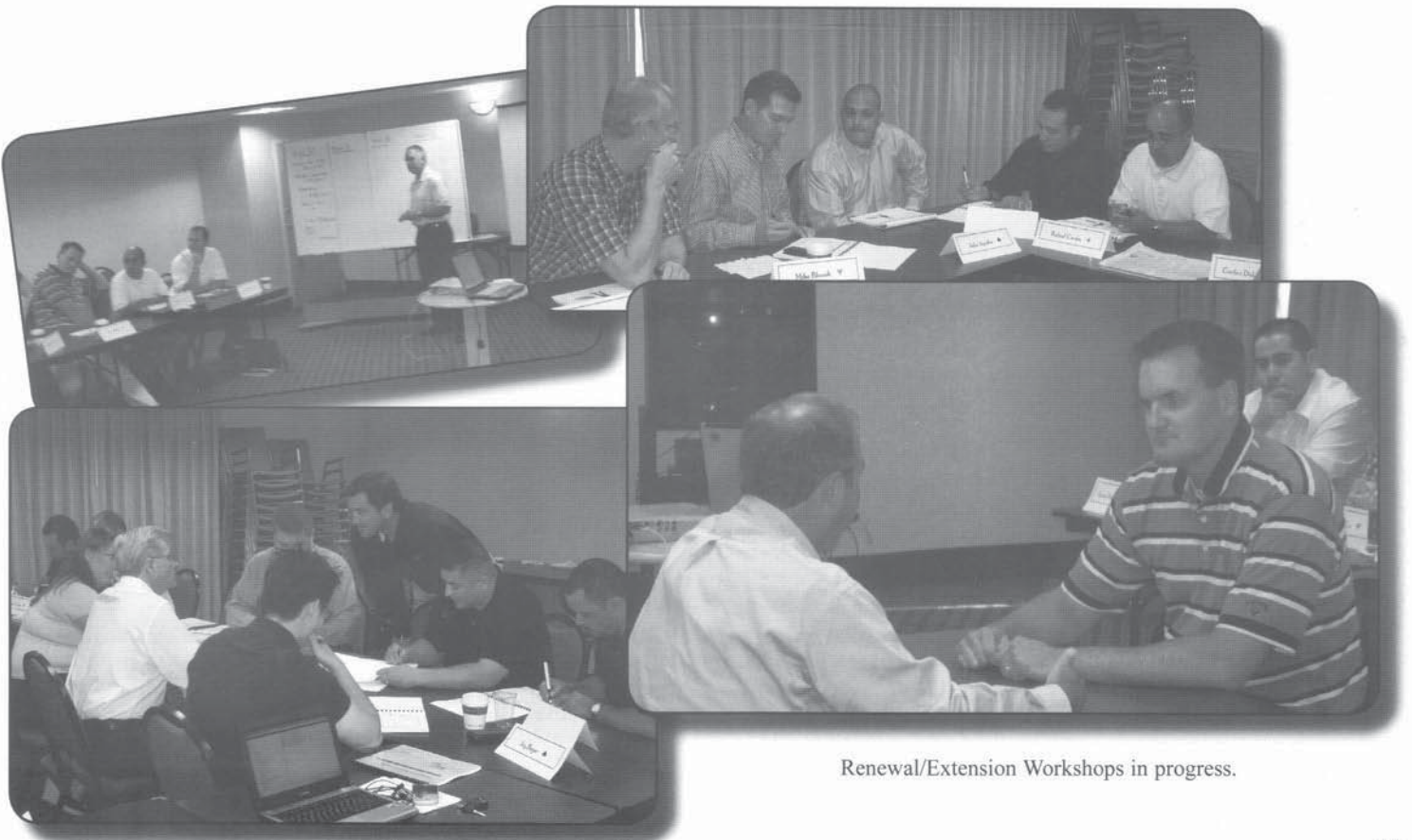

Project Update



A meeting was held on November 14, 2007 with the Regional Manager's Group to develop a revised ABS deployment schedule for the balance of 2007 and for 2008 and 2009. There are several key events in the new schedule:

- The stabilization of the Carson plant by the end of November 2007.
- The resolution of outstanding Stockroom issues in Irvine by the end of 2007.
- The deployment to all Northern Regional Industrial plants by the end of April 2008 beginning with Cerritos in early December 2007 followed by Fresno, Van Nuys, and Moorpark. Service Centers will be implemented concurrently with their respective plant implementations.
- The focus for the balance of 2008 will be the deployment of ABS to all Cleanroom plants beginning with Milpitas in May 2008 followed by LA, Richmond, Mesa, and Austin in that order.
- The focus for 2009 will be the continued deployment to the remaining Industrial plants beginning with Milpitas followed by LA, Phoenix, Chula Vista, Vista, Riverside, Albuquerque, and Tucson in that order. Again, the Service Centers will be implemented concurrently with their respective plants.

Baron's Says Our Industry Is Outpacing S&P 500.

AMERICA'S WORKFORCE IS looking spiffier these days, along with the companies that outfit a growing number of waiters, doormen, drivers and other employees. Twenty-six million civilians now wear uniforms at work, and their ranks are expected to grow by more than a million a year as companies seek to differentiate their workers from competitors and better identify them in an age of greater security risks.

The industry's sunny long-term prospects bode particularly well for the \$16 billion uniform-rental-and-servicing market.

Uniform companies profit chiefly from contracts for laundering and repairing rental uniforms, with five-year deals now the norm, up from two- or three-year pacts a decade ago. Some 90% of contracts are renewed, producing a solid, predictable cash stream.

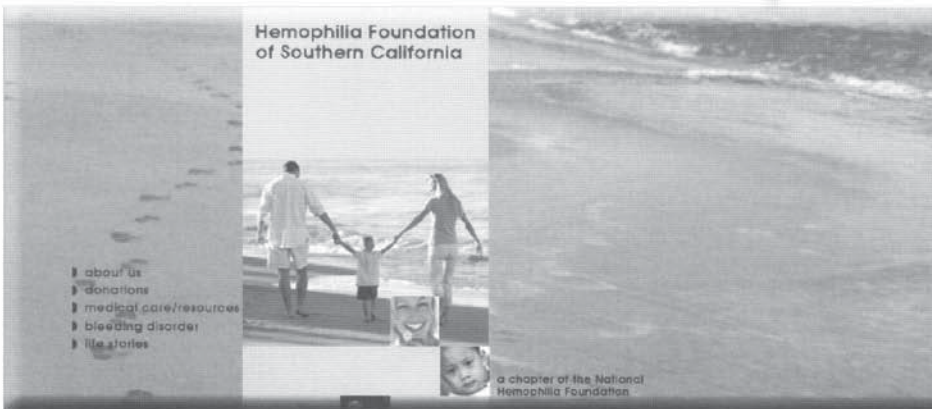
About half the industry's new growth has come from customers who previously weren't in uniform-rental programs.

The ability to "bundle" new and existing services is a big plus. "A hotel needs uniforms, and related services," says Curt Organt of T. Rowe Price.
