Reusable vs. Disposable

CLOTH NAPKINS vs. PAPER NAPKINS

Linen napkins can be reused over 100 times on average



Paper products accounted for over 28% of all landfill trash



Reusable vs. Disposable

CLOTH PATIENT GOWNS VS.



Cloth patient gowns can be reused over 50 times on average

Reusables greater environmental impact vs. disposables:

Climate shift 2x
Photochemical oxidation 3x
Eutrophication 19% more
Land use 12x
Water 40% more
Solid waste 9x
Fossil fuels 3x

Disposable patient gowns are used only once, before they end up in a landfill
