DAN CLARK'S MESSAGE

December, 2016

To Our Friends,

2016 has been both a challenging and rewarding year for POS. Our acquisition of December 2015 has stretched us to our limit. We acquired an existing plant in Colonial Heights, Virginia and five service centers. The Colonial Heights plant is the second largest of our existing plants in physical size. This acquisition gave our industrial service (our core business) a presence on the east coast (see map on back cover). In the near future this operation will become a great growth and profit opportunity for Prudential. This year we also opened two new service centers. One in St. Louis, Missouri and another in Boise, Idaho.

During the third quarter of 2017 we plan to open our 18th plant, in Nashua, New Hampshire. This plant will be built in three phases so it can grow revenue over the next thirty plus years. When all three phases are completed (and I surely will no longer be writing these Christmas letters) Nashua will be a 113,000 square foot building housing both an industrial and cleanroom plant on over 14 acres. Nashua will be twice the size of our average plant today.

In the early 50's, POS and its employees were forced to join unions; no one had a choice. Today our employees can choose. Prudential's philosophy is our employees have the right to join a union or the right not to join a union. I feel our non-union compensation and benefit plans are as good as or better than comparable union plans; and our employees are well protected since there are many State and Federal laws in place to ensure everyone of fair and equal treatment besides Prudential's own philosophy of caring for its employees. This year three long term union plants chose to go non-union. I thank our employees for trusting in Prudential to represent them fairly.

2016 has been a great growth year and I'd like to thank each one of our employees, customers and suppliers for making this happen.


At this time of year I cherish the privilege of expressing the company's sincere thanks to each of our employees, customers, suppliers and friends for the meaningful things that they have done for us in 2016, and to extend our heartfelt best wishes for 2017. It is my hope that we may keep the holiday spirit of faith, love and goodwill toward all alive throughout the year. May God grant each of you joy, peace, and happiness in this holiday season and coming year.

Para Nuestros Amigos,

El 2016 ha sido un año tanto desafiante como gratificante para POS. Nuestra adquisición de Diciembre del 2015 nos ha llevado a nuestro límite. Adquirimos una planta existente en Colonial Heights, Virginia y cinco centros de servicio. La planta en Colonial Heights es la segunda más grande de nuestras plantas existentes en tamaño físico. Esta adquisición dio a nuestro servicio industrial (nuestro negocio principal) una presencia en la costa este (ver mapa en la portada de atrás). En un futuro cercano esta operación se convertirá en una gran oportunidad de crecimiento y beneficio para Prudential. Este año también abrimos dos nuevos centros de servicio uno en St. Louis, Missouri y otro en Boise, Idaho.

Durante el tercer trimestre del 2017, tenemos planeado abrir nuestra planta número 18, en Nashua, New Hampshire. Esta planta se construirá en tres fases para que pueda incrementar ingresos durante los siguientes treinta o más años. Cuando se completen las tres fases (y seguramente ya no estaré escribiendo estas cartas de Navidad) Nashua será un edificio de 113,000 pies cuadrados que alberga tanto una planta industrial como una planta cleanroom en más de 14 acres. Nashua será el doble del tamaño de nuestra planta promedio hoy.

A principios de los años 50; POS y sus empleados se vieron obligados a unirse a sindicatos, nadie tenía una opción. Hoy nuestros empleados pueden elegir. La filosofía de Prudential es que nuestros empleados tienen derecho a afiliarse a un sindicato o el derecho a no afiliarse a un sindicato. Siento que nuestros planes de compensación y beneficios no sindicales son tan buenos o mejores que los planes sindicales; y nuestros empleados están bien protegidos, ya que hay muchas leyes estatales y federales en efecto para garantizar que todos tengan un trato justo y equitativo, además de la propia filosofía de Prudential de cuidar a sus empleados. Este año, tres plantas que por largo tiempo han sido sindicales, decidieron no sindicarse. Agradezco a nuestros empleados por confiar en Prudential para representarlos de manera justa.

2016 ha sido un gran año de crecimiento y quisiera dar las gracias a cada uno de nuestros empleados, clientes y proveedores por hacer esto posible.

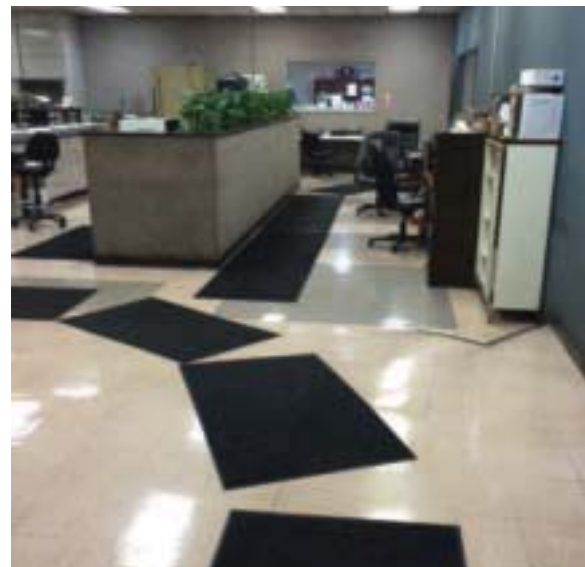

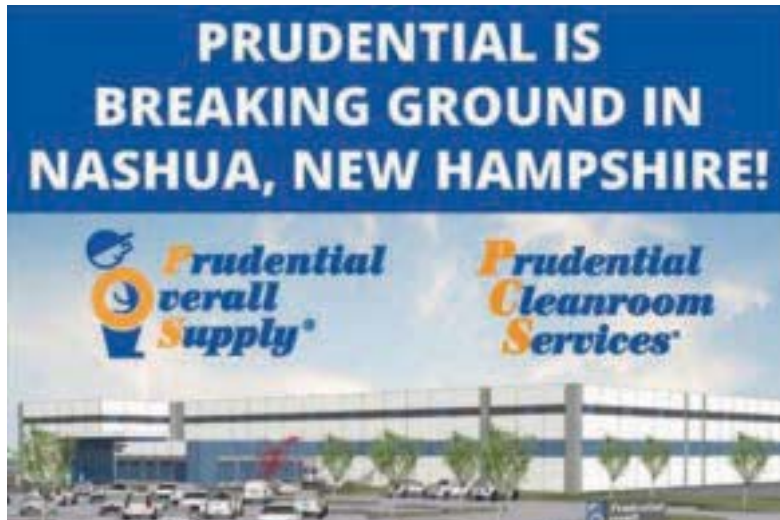

Reflecting California-based Prudential Overall Supply's (POS) growing competitive presence on the Eastern Seaboard, company officials joined with local and state leaders in Nashua, NH, for a Sept. 28 groundbreaking

ceremony that signaled the start of construction of a new cleanroom plant projected to be the largest facility of its kind in the United States. This \$15-million-plus POS investment will relieve pressure on a similar POS cleanroom plant in Richmond, VA, that currently employs 123 people. The new 70,000-square-foot Nashua plant is expected to employ roughly 50 people to start, with second- and third-phase expansion increasing its size to 115,000 square feet, said Stefan Schurter, senior vice president of POS.

The ceremony attracted about 50 local leaders. On hand were representatives from American Laundry Systems (ALS), Haverhill, MA, which is planning and engineering the plant; and Dacon Corp., a contractor based in Natick, MA, which will oversee construction of this Class III ISO cleanroom facility. The new plant should begin running sometime in the second or third quarter of 2017, ALS President and CEO Gerard O'Neill said.

"It will not just be Nashua's largest cleanroom plant, not just New England's largest cleanroom plant, or the East Coast's," Schurter said. "This will be the largest cleanroom laundry in the United States. It's really going to be a unique achievement. It's a first of a kind. We're really proud that we can build it. And I think it will really bring great jobs."

Previously established in the East with cleanroom operations, the company acquired operations in August 2015 from Coyne Textile Services, expanding POS industrial laundry rental service into Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia and West Virginia. This also put Alabama, Maryland and Washington DC within POS' reach.

One enduring legacy of POS's Depression-era origins is the fact that the company has always avoided indebtedness, Schurter said. To this day, POS remains "debt-free" and is funding the new plant from cash reserves alone, he said ...



When California-based Prudential Overall Supply went looking for a place to expand its business, it chose Nashua to build its newest facility and at its groundbreaking ceremony on Sept. 28, company officials said it will be a source of pride for the city. POS is the leader in cleanroom laundry services, which is important to industries such as aerospace and life sciences that need 21st century cleanliness in their processes. "This will be the largest cleanroom laundry in the United States," said Stefan Schurter, senior vice president. Business development manager Cynthia Harrington here at the Division of Economic Development, assisted the company in its expansion to Nashua. Schurter said that in the search for a location, Nashua became an obvious choice because of its infrastructure. "The city has put in sewer, water, gas and electric right at the site and that is foresight that we are benefitting from," he said. "We found the infrastructure here that

was really attractive and allowed us to build very quickly – that's a big thing." The new building, located on Simon Street, will be built in three phases; 70,000 square-feet in the first phase; 45,000 square-feet in the second phase and concluded with 16,280-square feet. "It will bring some really great jobs," Schurter said. "They are all full-time jobs with benefits. We truly believe that if you invest in people, people will invest with you." Jeffrey Rose, commissioner of the Department of Resources and Economic Development, said he joins city officials in welcoming POS to New Hampshire. "The capabilities it provides are vital to the many companies whose advanced manufacturing processes require high tech industrial laundry services," he said. "We looking forward to watching this company grow and prosper in New Hampshire."
