
Serving Prudential Overall Supply for over 44 years, Tom Watts announced his retirement effective January 17, 2020. Tom will remain a member of the Board of Directors.

Founded by the Clark family in 1932, Prudential employs a staff of 1,850-plus people in 35 locations throughout the United States.

TRSA Chair Jim Buik, Roscoe Co., noted that the Executive Committee's decision, "Gives us tremendous pleasure to recognize Tom's contributions and support of the linen, uniform and facility services industry with the TRSA Operator Lifetime Achievement Award, bestowed only upon professionals in recognition of their exceptional personal service to our industry and to the associations that serve the industry."

Watts is a longtime, active member of TRSA who has served in many capacities and is a current member of its Board of Directors. He is a 1989 graduate of TRSA's Executive Management Institute (EMI) and a regular attendee and contributor to many of TRSA's professional-development programs. Prudential Chairman of the Board and CEO Dan Clark nominated Watts for this honor, citing his qualities of honesty, integrity and industry knowledge as key factors that have allowed him to succeed not only as a mentor and teacher to his employees but also in the setting and accomplishing of goals that have allowed Prudential to achieve outstanding growth during his term as president.

TOM WATTS LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT: WATTS EMPHASIZES INDUSTRY SOLIDARITY

Tom Watts, president of Prudential Overall Supply, Irvine, CA, told a crowd of nearly 200 people at TRSA's Sept. 19 Awards Dinner during the 106th Annual Conference that he felt like the entire industry should receive recognition for its work. However, he graciously accepted the laundry industry's highest honor, the Operator Lifetime Achievement Award, thanking his wife, Marcy, and Prudential Chairman Dan Clark for their many years of personal and professional support.

"I will say this," said Watts, in a lighthearted address that capped a 43-year career at Prudential that began in 1975 with a job as a route service representative, "Everybody in this room that I've met over the years and people that aren't in this room that I've met over the years, they've been so willing to help I almost feel like it's the entire industry that should get this award."

He quipped that he'd take custody of the award, noting that, "I'll keep it for you. But anyone that wants to come see it, you can come see it '

Speaking of industry unity, he noted that while fiercely competitive, commercial laundry companies in California do look out for each other when crises such as natural disasters strike the Golden State. "In California, we have earthquakes and every once in a while freeways collapse, bridges go down and it's devastating," Watts told the crowd gathered at the Hyatt Regency Boston Harbor near Logan Airport. "But every time we've been in one of those situations, we've gotten calls from competitors, people that we compete with every day on the streets, saying 'If you need any help, call us. We'll do whatever you need. People have actually reached out and said, 'Look, we want to keep you in business. It's good for the industry. We've very much appreciated that."

Watts appreciates Marcy and their two children as well, though the latter two work on the West Coast and were unable to attend the program. "They're working for a living," he said, adding with a laugh, "That's good. They're not on my payroll."

In thanking his wife, Watts noted that a career as an executive in the laundry business requires many long hours and dedication. Marcy's help was a key ingredient to Watts' success he said. "There's a number of people I want to say thank you to," Watts said. "First and foremost is my wife Marcy for her support and understanding. As many of you in this business



know, it's not a 9-5 job, it's an all-day career. So I want to thank her for her support."

With a touch of self-deprecating humor, Watts also thanked Clark and his wife Laura "for keeping me around for all these years." Watts, who rose through the ranks at Prudential from a route manager, sales and service manager, general manager, operations manager and finally, as president of the familyowned company, reflected on his many long drives with Dan to visit customers, an experience he found both challenging and rewarding. Watts joked that he also should be recognized for enduring those many trips over the years. "We spend 5-6 weeks on the road together visiting every one of our locations, putting on a state of the company meeting as well as explain to our employees about our profit-sharing and 401 (k) plan," he said. "It's extensive it's time-committing, very grueling. But let me just say this: If you're in a car with someone for 10 solid hours, driving from Tucson to El Paso, Texas, and back the same night and having two meetings and listening to Abba and Judy Collins round and round. Just that, I deserve some kind of award but

On a more serious note, Watts thanked Clark "primarily for surrounding me with some of the best people that we've ever found in the industry or anywhere that just make me look good. I've been fortunate enough to have them line up some great people, talented people that we've had over the years. It just makes the job that much easier."

Watts concluded with kudos to the industry at large, including vendors, as well the association. "Thank you to the industry, TRSA members, staff, all of the suppliers, all of the vendors in the room that have supported Prudential over the years," he said. "You have made the job much more pleasant and easy to earn this award. Thank you very much."

PRUDENTIAL OVERALL SUPPLY RECEIVES VPP STAR SITE **RECOGNITION FOR ITS MESA, AZ CLEANROOM FACILITY**

The Arizona Division of Occupational Safety and Health (ADOSH) Consultation Department presented Prudential Overall Supply, with its "STAR Site" designation through the Voluntary Protection Program, "VPP" on June 12, 2019. Companies and jobsites that are awarded the STAR designation demonstrate exemplary and comprehensive safety and health management systems.

ADOSH held a VPP Ceremony at Prudential's Mesa, AZ cleanroom laundry processing plant where the location was awarded the STAR designation and presented with the VPP plaque and flag. During the ceremony, Brandon Stowell, Compliance Assistance Specialist Supervisor, spoke on the significance of a VPP achievement and its importance to the State of Arizona.

Prudential Awarded VPP

"This is the third time Prudential Overall Supply has been recognized with the STAR designation. It's so important for companies to receive this recognition because they become the model for top safety in the workplace," said Stowell.

"Prudential Overall Supply really is a STAR site when it comes to factoring in the health and safety of every employee on the team.'

VPP is the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA) highest program of recognition across the United States. It recognizes employers and workers in private and federal workplaces who have exemplified effective safety and health management systems. On average a VPP Star worksite has a Days Away Restricted or Transferred (DART) case rate of 52% below the average for its industry.

To qualify for VPP status, employers must submit an application to OSHA, have at least three consecutive years of incident rates below industry average and undergo an onsite evaluation by a team of safety and health professionals. VPP participants and sites earning the "STAR Site" designation are re-evaluated every three to five years in order to remain in the program. VPP participants are exempt from OSHA programmed inspections while they maintain their VPP

Currently, only 47 Arizona companies out of more than 135,000 are VPP "Stars."

CLEANROOM ATTIRE: CRITICAL COMPONENTS FOR OPTIMAL SAFETY

Jerry Martin, VP of Sales & Marketing at Prudential Overall Supply, explains the essentials of safe cleanroom garments.

It has been estimated that 80% of the contaminants found in a typical cleanroom originate from people. Given the inherently non-sterile nature of human beings, this is hardly surprising.

The human scalp, for instance, contains about one million microorganisms per square centimeter. And these organisms can spread around with alarming ease—in fact, people routinely introduce contaminants into their immediate environment just by talking or moving around. The more physically active they are, the more pollutants they shed.

But cleanroom managers are not just handling threats to sensitive materials caused by humans; they must also deal with hazards that can endanger the health of their personnel.

Take arc flashes for example. Worn conductors, loose wires, or (most frequently) human oversight can create a devastating three-phase arc flash that reaches 35,000 °F (19,426 °C) in under one-thousandth of a second. Arc flash incidents sometimes result in fatal injuries; even less serious episodes often leave victims with damaged eyesight, burned skin, and other lasting impairments.

All of this is certainly a lot to contend with, but fortunately, cleanroom operators have access to appropriate and effective attire and accessories to help them maintain a safe and secure workplace environment.

This specialized cleanroom apparel has a dual function—it enables personnel to shield themselves against hazardous laboratory phenomena and prevent contaminants from harming valuable products.

ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF CLEANROOM APPAREL

Cleanroom apparel consists of various pieces that, when donned correctly, form a "suit" that covers most, or all, of the wearer's body. A standard suit will generally consist of the following components...





TUCSON RESIDENT BEGINS PEACE CORPS SERVICE IN TONGA

WASHINGTON – America Valencia of Tucson has been accepted into the Peace Corps and will depart for Tonga on August 19, 2019, to begin training as an education volunteer. Valencia will serve as an English literacy facilitator.

"I wanted to experience a different culture by completely immersing myself in it, rather than experiencing it for a few days via tourism," said Valencia of her desire to join the Peace Corps.

Valencia is the daughter of Frank and Priscilla Valencia of Tucson and a graduate of University High School in Tucson. She attended University of Arizona (UA) in Tucson, where she earned a bachelor's degree in literacy, learning and leadership in May 2019. Prior to joining the Peace Corps, she acted as a peer mentor at UA's Project FOCUS and as floor staff at The Loft Cinema.


During the first three months of her service, Valencia will live with a host family in Tonga to become fully immersed in the country's language and culture. Peace Corps volunteers return from service as global citizens well-positioned for professional opportunities in today's global job market.


