To Whom It May Concern:

AdvaCare Disinfectant, part of the AdvaCare Laundry System, is an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registered laundry disinfectant. The EPA product registration number is 1677-193, and it is registered in all 50 states. The concentrate formulation is approved for use in commercial, institutional, healthcare and industrial laundry operations.

When added to the laundry following label instructions at a rate of 4 fluid ounces per hundred pounds of dry laundry at 140°F, the formulation meets the EPA requirements for laundry disinfection (complete kill in 9 out 9 carriers with a 6 log or greater organisms per carrier) for the following organisms:

- Acinetobacter baumannii (ATCC19606)
- Escherichia coli 0157:H7 (ATCC 43895)
- Klebsiella pneumoniae (ATCC 4352)
- Listeria monocytogenes (ATCC 49594)
- Methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA) (ATCC 33592)
- Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus aureus (CA-MRSA) (ATCC BAA-1556)
- Pseudomonas aeruginosa (ATCC 15442)
- Salmonella enterica (ATCC 10708)
- Staphylococcus aureus (ATCC 6538)
- HIV-1 Virus*
